4. STATE POLICY UPDATES

- Bill HB2120/SB2634 authorizing TACIR to do a feasibility study on the Fresh Food Financing Initiative that would use income from a <1% food tax on SSB's to incentivize grocery stores to move to food deserts. When the time comes, FPC should draft a letter.
- Bill HB2229/SB2104 in House on de-regulation of homemade foods labeling. Un-likely to advance.
